The 2nd NOBIS Young Researchers' Day strives to attract young members of the scientific community, who usually depend on temporary, third-party funded projects. NOBIS intends to provide a platform for information exchange and networking, especially, during these early stages of a scientific career. The keynote by Gerald M. Schneeweiss on "phylogeny and evolution of the non-photosynthetic parasitic broomrapes (Orobanchaceae)" will provide a glimpse into the strange world of plants gone astray.

We encourage especially young scientists to send their abstracts and to apply for the NOBIS Award 2017. For the first time, two awards, one for master and one for PhD students, are awarded with 300.- Euro each and three years of free NOBIS memberships. These awards are prizes for just completed or nearly finished scientific projects. Applicants will be invited to present their results and a jury will announce the winner during the meeting. Additionally, the best poster is elected by public vote and awarded with three years of free NOBIS membership.
