NOBIS Awards 2025

In the frame of the 19th annual meeting, NOBIS Austria will confer the NOBIS Awards 2025 for excellent research in the field of biological systematics. They are dedicated to young members of the scientific community. Two awards, one for master and one for PhD students' talks, will be conferred, each with 500.- Euro and a three years NOBIS membership. These awards are prizes for just completed (< than 1 year ago) or nearly finished scientific projects.

Applicants should indicate their applications in the registration form and send their abstract together with a short scientific curriculum (one page) to nobis@nhm.at. Please, use the abstract form on our homepage www.nobis-austria.at.

Among the applicants the candidates are selected by the NOBIS Board and the Advisory Board. Candidates will be invited to present their results at the 19th annual meeting of NOBIS Austria (28th November 2025; inatura Dornbirn), and a jury will select the winner during the meeting.

Additionally, the best poster will be elected by public vote and awarded with 200.- Euro and a three years NOBIS membership.

The evaluation will be based on scientific significance as well as on the quality of the presentation.

NOBIS membership is required at the time of submission.
